## COMMUNICATE, COMMUNICATE, COMMUNICATE

Currently, our Azan members receive information by way of the Azan News, Email, Telephone and the US Postal Service. It has been brought to our attention that many of our members rely heavily on text messaging via cell phones. (Text messaging is not a service you sign up and pay for, it is included with your cell service.) Many Masonic organizations currently use Text Messaging to announce upcoming events. We're excited to announce that Azan Shrine is going to move forward with Text Messaging to its members, starting in August. Messages will be short and closely controlled so that no member is inundated with large numbers of texts. It will not be used for sales or marketing purposes, just COMMUNICATIONS. All Text messages will be pre-approved by our Potentate. We are looking forward to serving you. We will use Webfez (membership database maintained by Imperial Shrine) to collect members' cell phone numbers. Additional cell phone numbers can be added upon request.

Here is a SAMPLE of a typical Text Message from Azan Shrine:
