Messages will be short and closely controlled so that no member is inundated with large numbers of texts. It will not be used for sales or marketing purposes, just COMMUNICATIONS. All Text messages will be pre-approved by our Potentate. We are looking forward to serving you. We will use Webfez (membership database maintained by Imperial Shrine) to collect members' cell phone numbers. Additional cell phone numbers can be added upon request.
