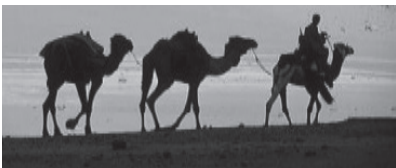
The July 13 Memorial for Robert Wicker was well attended, and I am sure Bobby would have appreciated it. It was a great tribute to our departed Brother and Noble.
